Note: The proposed fee structure shall be applicable to students admitted from academic session 2025-26 (New admission). The existing fee structure will be applicable for old students. However, as per notification no. F 3 (34B)/ Budget/AUK/2024/3141-49 dated:06.02.2025 issued by Comptroller, AU, Kota, the latest revised fees structure for the certificates/ documents issued by the Controller of Examinations office will be charged equally from all the students irrespective of their year of admission.

7. Exemption for paying fees:

The following categories of students are exempted from paying tuition fee:

1. Women students of UG classes in all colleges (in PG classes, they have to pay half tuition fee).
2. Students belonging to SC, ST, and OBC classes.
3. Ex-servicemen or their dependents that have been disabled permanently and have settled in Rajasthan and from the dependents living in Rajasthan of those killed as of hostilities on Indian borders.
4. Children/wives of those Armed Force/Border Security Force are Armed Police personnel belonging to Rajasthan, who were killed in action or rendered permanent disabled during the hostilities on Indian border (will not be charged tuition fee and other fee excluding fees deposited in students fund). The concession will also be admissible to the personnel themselves who were rendered permanently disabled and now desire to pursue studies in University Colleges.

Note: The above concession will be admissible to a student on production of 'Entitlement card from the record officer of the armed forces and police authorities to the head of the institution.

5. Children of non-income tax paying employees of (a) state Government (b) AU, Kota (c) High court and its subordinate courts (d) Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad and (e) Central Government posted in Rajasthan and state funded Universities (A student whose father is alive will not be considered dependent upon any other person. In case, however, the father is invalid, brother could be considered his guardian).
6. Children belonging to families selected under IRP scheme by the State Govt. will be exempted from the payment of tuition fee by Vice Chancellor on production of eligibility certificate from the authority.

Note: Students claiming exemption in the above categories are required to submit necessary certificate from the competent authorities along with the admission form.

7. Students admitted under the category of orphan are fully exempted for paying tuition fee development fee and hostel fee.
8. Tuition fee from students taking less than 9 credits hrs. in a semester after completion of the prescribed period of residential requirement will be charged at half the rate of the semester. Students taking 9 credits or more are required to pay full tuition fee. All other fees will be charged at fully rate.

Note: Students are advised to preserve all fee receipt paid to college with care for subsequent reference.

In cash class, poor and deserving candidates are offered full free ship to the extent of one student or half free ship to the extent of one student per class.

- Poor students are also given aid from the poor boy's fund to meet their expenses towards tuition or examination fee or for the purchase of books.
- A limited number of needy students are provided an opportunity to earn a part of their cost of living by working in the college workshop and instructional farm and other places.

8. Refund of fees

- (i) In the event of a freshly admitted candidate withdrawing from the UG/PG/Ph.D. programme after getting registration, the deposited fee (normal and payment fee excluding security fee) shall be refunded after deductions as per the following rates during ongoing admission process:

(i) Up to 7 days of his/her registration	10%
(ii) After 7 days to one month	25%
(iii) After one month up to 2 months	50%

Note: The duration for refund of fee shall be counted from the date of registration of a candidate

- (ii) No fee except security deposit will be refunded, if a student leaves the course and seat remains vacant after completion of the admission process.
- (iii) For the refund of fee, the student/candidate withdrawing shall give in writing that he/she intends to withdraw.

9. Fee chargeable from foreign students

(i) The fee shall be payable by bank in US dollars or any other currency acceptable by nationalized banks in India issued against the bank account in the account of foreign students in the country in which he/she is residing or in the shape of bank draft in equivalent Indian currency issued against foreign students account of the foreign students maintained in India. In the latter case, the candidates are required to submit a certificate from the bank that the fund has been issued against the foreign students account maintained by the foreign students. The bank draft should be drawn in favor of the Comptroller, Agriculture University, Kota payable at ICICI Bank Ltd., or any scheduled bank at Kota, Rajasthan, India.
